8th Grade Band Supplies List:

- Students have now progressed enough that they should seriously be considering two points:
 - o A New Instrument
 - Private Lessons

New Instrument:

Beginning instruments are designed to have the basic sound produced quickly and easily. This sound is usually not the highest quality. As the player learns to play, they can now produce a higher quality sound than the instrument is capable of producing. In other words, the instrument is holding the student back. The next level of instrument is the intermediate level. If you are renting your instrument, there is a step-up program. If you own your instrument, there are many places you can trade it in for an intermediate instrument.

Lessons:

 Students have progressed far enough now that most students are ready for individual private instruction. The best way to improve on your instrument is by instruction by a specialist. Mr. Roberts has contact information for area private instructors for each instrument. Lessons occur once each week and cost approximately \$15 per lesson. I cannot express enough the importance and benefit that taking private lessons has.

Supplies and Equipment:

- Standard of Excellence Festival Solos Book 2
- Standard of Excellence Festival Ensembles Book 2
- Trophy Flip Folder
- <u>Lyre</u> These are instrument specific. If you are unsure, ask Mr. Roberts.

Students should already have:

- Maintenance Kit, Music Stand, Pencil, Binder, Tuner/Metronome Combo Korg TM-50, Festival Solos Book 1, Festival Ensembles Book 1

Clarinet/Saxophone Reeds:

- Clarinets should now play on Vandoren 2½ or 3 reeds. They are about \$22 for 10 reeds.
- Saxophones should get Vandoren 2½ or 3 reeds. They are about \$25 for 10 reeds.
- If students are careful, they will not go through more than 10 per quarter, hopefully less.

Trumpets:

Percussionists:

- New sticks/mallets
 - Vic Firth American <u>Custom T1</u> General Timpani Mallets \$25.25
